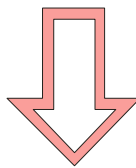

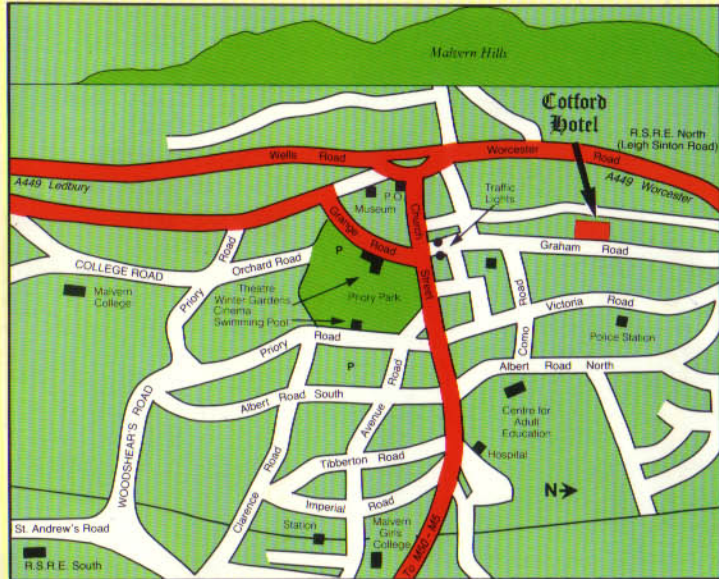
Boat trips on the River Severn leave from Worcester. Steam trains run on the Severn Valley Railway.

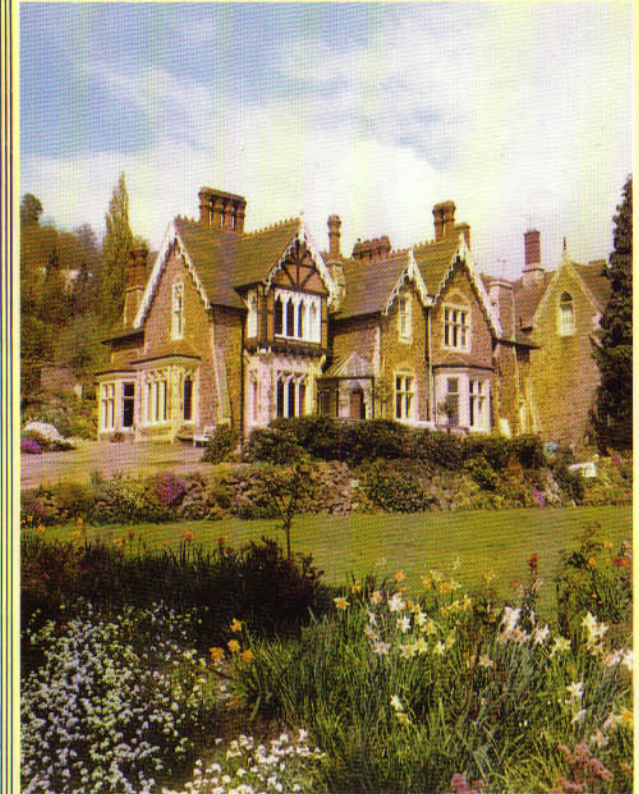
